Event Cancellation and Interruption

Planning an event is a matter of detailed organizing and substantial financial commitments. Yet event the best plans are at the mercy of outside forces that are uncontrollable. Gain confidence with JZA's Event Cancellation Insurance protection. We can protect your organization from the time you spend your first dollar on an event until 5 days after your event has ended.

Your organization will be protected from financial losses caused by fire, collapse or destruction of the convention site - strikes involving labor, transportation and services - non-appearance of main attractions, adverse weather, such as blizzards, floods, tornadoes, hurricanes - even earthquakes and power failures. Any insured description that results in a partial loss due to a reduced attendance or forces you to cancel, postpone, curtail or abandon your meeting is covered.

Main Features

§ Automatic Extension of coverage- all meetings during the policy period with budgeted gross revenue of \$50,000 or less are covered.

§ Automatic coverage for Newly Acquired shows and Meetings- up to \$250,000 of additional coverage for newly acquired shows for up to 90 days.

§ Business & Personal Property Coverage- to \$125,000 of coverage at the convention site including while in transit to and from the convention site.

§ Automatic Coverage up to \$100,000- to recover physically lost or stolen door registration receipts.

§ Single policy for multiple events at a discounted premium.

§ 10% Upward Coverage Limit for Commitments such as hotel room blocks, food and beverage commitments.

How Much Coverage is Needed?

You should include all event-related revenues, commitments and expenditures. Any out of pocket expenses in organizing the event and financial commitments would be included as well as the income you expect to generate from the event above and beyond expenses.

Now is the time to buy event cancellation insurance. Most event planners apply for coverage while they are preparing their event budget. That enables them to include the modest cost for this insurance in their budget. As soon as expenses are incurred, insurance should be purchased. The cost of coverage is such that it will fit into a well-planned budget.
